TRAIL DESCRIPTION: Mostly a flat sidewalk trail along the streets of this historic community. Strollers easy. Wheelchairs easy. Pets: leashed.

TRAIL BACKGROUND: This walk goes through residential sections of Princeton before winding through the festival. For over 23 years, the Arts Council of Princeton and the students of Princeton University have collaborated to bring Princeton's largest cultural event to the community, Communiversy Festival of the Arts. Enjoy this spirited outdoor event featuring continuous live entertainment on four stages, numerous artists and crafters, children's activities and games, and a wide array of delicious food from around the globe. More than 100 artists, crafters, merchants, and local organizations will participate on a Sunday in April as they exhibit their wares on Nassau and Witherspoon Streets, which will be closed to traffic during the event.

REGISTRATION/FEES: Fee for IVV credit is \$3. For non-IVV members we are requesting a \$3 donation to assist in covering our expenses.

CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of weather conditions, but keep in mind that severe weather will increase the trail difficulty. Pets are permitted if leashed. There will be no refunds.

AWARD: There is no special Award for this event. There is no pre-registration.

EVENT PROCEDURE: At the start point, each participant will receive a start card, which must be filled out legibly with the individual's name and address (preprinted address labels are suggested). The start card must be carried during the event and personally presented at control points along the trail. Participants missing a control point may be refused an award/or IVV credit. All cards remain the property of the sponsoring club and must be turned in at the completion of the event.

ELIGIBILITY: Anyone is welcome to participate in the walk. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult along the trail.

IVV RECORD BOOKS: Participants are reminded to bring their IVV record books. Additional books will be available for purchase at \$5 each.

REFRESHMENTS: Snack bar in Frist Campus Center, numerous restaurants along Nassau & Witherspoon Streets & many food vendors participating in Communiversy.
