DIRECTIONS TO: Sherwood Pavilion, 19th and Moore Streets

From State College: Take US 26 South. Turn right on Cold Springs Rd (SR 1009). Turn left on Moore St.

From Pittsburgh: Take I-376 East to US 22 East. Follow US 22 East to Huntingdon. *Follow directions **From US 22 East below.**

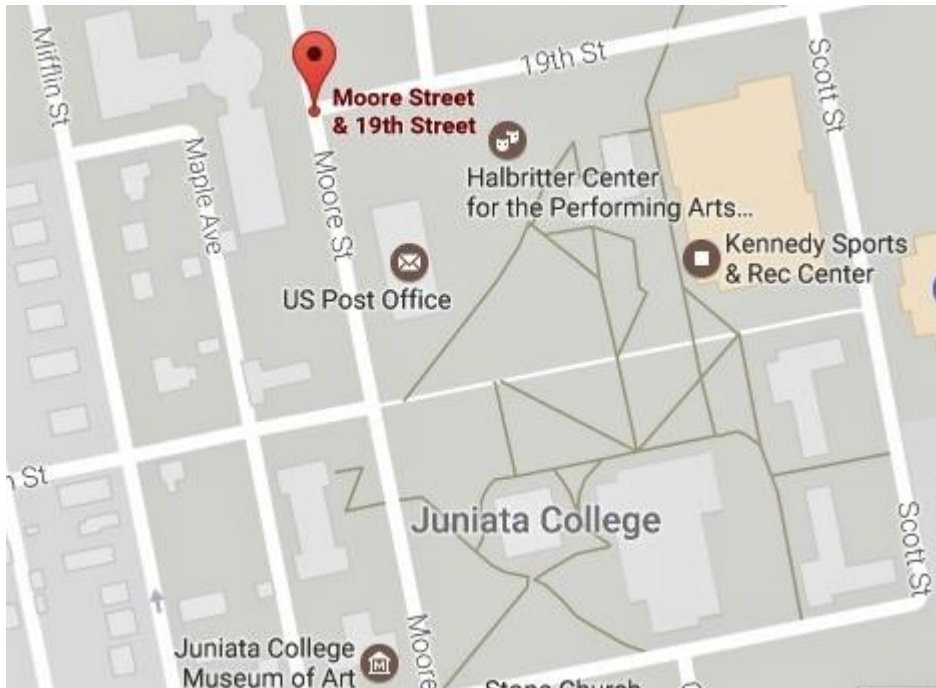
From Harrisburg: Take US 322/22 West to Lewistown. Continue on US 22 West toward Mount Union. Follow US 22 West to Huntingdon. **Follow directions **From US 22 West below.**

From Philadelphia: Take I-76 West to Exit 180. Follow PA 522 North to US 22 West to Huntingdon.

***From US 22 East:** Turn left at the intersection of Fairgrounds Rd and US 22. Turn right at bottom of exit ramp onto Fairground Rd. Continue through 2 traffic lights. Turn left onto 6th St. Turn left on Moore St.

****From US 22 West:** Turn right at the intersection of Fairgrounds Rd and US 22. Turn right at bottom of exit ramp onto Fairground Rd. Continue through 2 traffic lights. Turn left onto 6th St. Turn left on Moore St.

Parking is available near the pavilion on 19th Street.

DATE: Saturday, May 20 – Sunday, May 21, 2017

SANCTIONED BY: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports. This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV Achievement awards.

PROCEDURE: AVA policy requires that every participant, fee or non-fee, sign the insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card which is stamped at control points along the course. At the Finish, the validated card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the credit fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome to participate. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Walk at your own pace. Runners are welcome!

REGISTRATION and FEES: This event is free to those who wish to participate without IVV credit. IVV credit is \$3.00. There will be no refunds. An award will not be available for this event. Also, no pre-registration for this event.

CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of the weather. There will be no littering. Wildlife and plant life are not to be disturbed. No refunds. Pets must be on a leash at all times and are not permitted in any buildings.

RESTROOMS: Restrooms are available at the start and en route.

REFRESHMENTS: Water and hard candy will be available at the start/finish. The 10K walk passes by numerous dining options.
