General Event Information

Sanctioned: All events in this brochure are sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). These events count for acquisition of IVV achievement awards.

Disclaimer: The American Volkssport Association or its subsidiary clubs are not responsible for theft or loss of personal belongings or property. All participants must sign a waiver.

Sponsor: Virginia Volkssport Association (AVA-VA)

Distances: 5 and 10 kilometers for all three events.

Start Times: All walks will start from 9 am until noon, finish by 3 pm.

Eligibility: All are welcome. Everyone must register and sign the insurance waiver at the start, fill out and carry a start card and turn it in upon completing the walk. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

Awards: There are A Awards (similar to the pictures on the front) for all events. Each of the awards is 4x3. 15 of each award will be available and will be not be reordered..

Fees: There is no charge to participate. The cost of each award and credit will be \$9 for Pre-Registered, and \$10 after May 13, 2017. Credit only is \$3. There will be no refund of any monies paid.

Conditions: These events will be held regardless of most weather conditions. Carry water regardless of weather conditions. IVV Books and New Walker packets will be available for sale at all events. The trails may be difficult for wheelchairs and strollers. Pets are welcome on the trail, but not in the start points.

Refreshments: Water and candy will be available at the start/finish and checkpoints. Restrooms will be available at the start point, but may not be available on the trail. Restrooms will not be available at the start point on Monday until the museum opens at 10 a.m.

Year Rounds: There are several year round and seasonal events in the area that will help you fill out your day.

Saturday, May 27, 2017 - GOOCHLAND COUNTY

Start Point: YMCA, 1800 Dickinson Road, Goochland, VA. GPS: N37° 41.6036', W077° 53.1543'

Trail Description: Rated 1A: This walk will be along town sidewalks and paved trails and roads. Small section of gravel.

Directions: . On I-64 between Richmond and Charlottesville, take Exit 159, US-522 South, approx. 7 mile to traffic light where US-522 turns left and joins River Road. After turn, quickly turn left on Dickenson Road (VA-396) and left into YMCA parking lot.

Qualifies for AVA Special Programs: Animal Safari, Bridges, National Register of Historic Places, United States Post Offices, Walking the USA - Street by Street (AL, AR, GA, LA, MS, ND, NY, OH, TX, WI), Water Towers., You'll Never Walk Alone.. Also, qualifies for Virginia Counties program: Goochland County.

Sunday, May 28, 2017 - LOUISA COUNTY

Start Point: Hardee's, 413 East Main Street, Louisa, VA. GPS: N38° 1.2275', W077° 59.5861'

Trail Description: Trail rating: 1A. This walk will be along town sidewalks and paved trails and roads.

Directions: On I-64 between Richmond and Charlottesville, take the VA-208 exit, EXIT 143, toward Louisa/Ferncliff. Turn right (from Richmond) onto Courthouse Rd/VA-208 for 8.68 miles. Turn right onto E Main St/US-33 E/VA-208/VA-22 for 0.40 miles. Start point is on the left. Park in the shopping center parking lot, not Hardee's parking lot.

Qualifies for AVA Special Programs: Honoring Our Flag, National Register of Historic Places, Trekking with the Trees, U S Post Offices, Walking the USA - Street by Street (IA, IL, IN, KS, KY, MI, MN, MO, MS, NC, ND, NM, OH, PA, TN, TX, VA), Water Towers, You'll Never Walk Alone. Also, qualifies for Virginia Counties program: Louisa County.

Monday, May 29, 2017 - NELSON COUNTY

Start Point: Walton's Mountain Museum, 6484 Rockfish Road, Schuyler, VA. GPS: N37° 47.4805', W078° 42.1056'

Trail Description: Trail rating: 2B. The walk will be an out and back walk along county roads. Some roads are dirt and some are paved. Schuyler is the town where Earl Hamner (of Walton's Mountain Fame) grew up.

Directions: . Take I-64 to Exit 121 at Charlottesville. Turn left (coming from Richmond) onto Monticello Ave/VA-20. Continue to follow VA-20 for approximately 12 miles. Turn right onto Plank Rd/VA-712 for approximately 0.02 miles. Turn left onto Elmont Rd for 4.89 miles. Turn left onto Paces Store Rd for approximately 0.11 miles. Take the 1st right onto Irish Rd/VA-6 for 4.24 miles. Turn left onto Schuyler Rd 2.19 miles. Turn right onto Rockfish River Rd/VA-617 for 0.08 miles. Start point is on the right. Do not park in front of the building. Leave that parking for regular museum visitors.

Qualifies for AVA Special Programs: Bridges, National Register of Historic Places, United States Post Offices, You'll Never Walk Alone. Also, qualifies for Virginia Counties program: Nelson County.
