

DIRECTIONS TO START/FINISH LOCATION

FROM RT. I-95 NORTH OR SOUTH -TAKE EXIT FOR RT. 32 EAST toward Ft. Meade. Continue to Exit 12B **RT. 1 South** toward Laurel for one block. ***TURN RIGHT** on Howard St. which will become Baltimore St. United Methodist Church (9050) is on the corners of Baltimore & Foundry Streets.

FROM RT. 295 (BALTO/WASH PKWY) NORTH or SOUTH TAKE EXIT FOR RT. 32 WEST toward Columbia. Continue and **TAKE EXIT 12B RT. 1 South** for Historic Savage. ***FOLLOW DIRECTIONS ABOVE.**

Parking in Church lot allowed and on streets.
BE SURE TO OBEY ALL SIGNS & RESTRICTIONS:



History: Trails pass many original structures dating from as early as 1816, including an industrial complex that was a leading producer of cotton duck. Much of the Mill complex now serves as a delightful series of artists' studios, shops, antique stores and restaurants. Other sections of trail follow the rapids of the Little Patuxent River which powered the mill and several blocks of brick homes that housed workers.

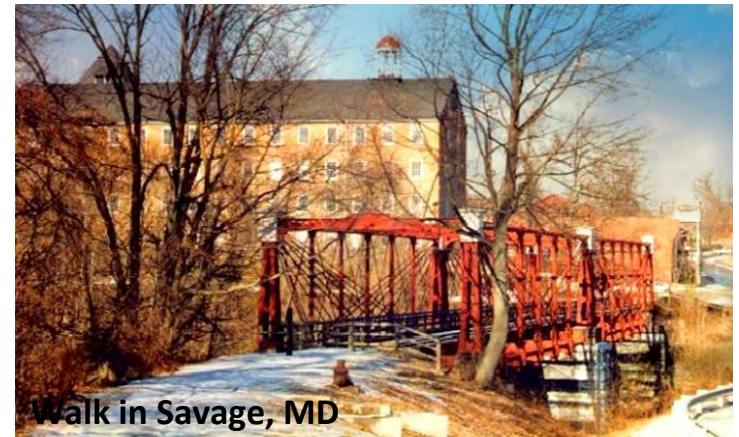

START/FINISH: Savage United Methodist Church, 9050 Baltimore St., Savage, MD 20763 in the Fellowship Hall. See drive directions on back of brochure.

TIMES: Start time anytime between 8:30 AM and 12 Noon finish by 3 PM.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION/DISTANCE: EVERYONE SHOULD CARRY WATER ON THE TRAIL. There is a 10-Km trail with a 5-km option with a rating of 2B. The trails are on sidewalks, paved pathways and natural wooded areas in and near the Savage Mill Historic District and the Bollman Iron Truss Bridge.

ELIGIBILITY: These walks are open to the public. Everyone is welcome to participate.

REGISTRATION: The fee for IVV Credit or Non-IVV Credit is \$3.00. Children 12 and under (IVV-Credit included) walk for free courtesy of Freestate Happy Wanderers. The same trail may be walked for credit twice on the same start card on the same day with no extra charge.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Honoring Our Flag, Bridges, National Register of Historic Places, United States Post Offices.

PROCEDURE: Each participant must register at the start and completely fill out a start card and including signing the waiver. The start card is to be carried on the walk and presented at each checkpoint. Participants must turn in start cards at the Finish Table after completing the event.

CONDITIONS: Littering along the trails is prohibited. Howard County law requires that all pets be leashed and that owners clean up after their pets. Pets NOT permitted in the start building. The event will be held in all reasonable weather. If weather conditions are uncertain, and travelers' advisories are in effect on the day of the event, please call the contact person listed to obtain up-to-date information on event status.

AMENITIES: Water, restrooms and hard candy are available at the Start/Finish. Please carry your water bottles on the trail.
