



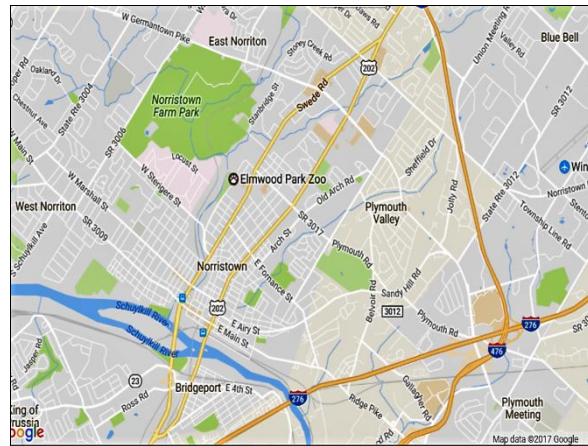
PICNIC

DIRECTIONS

From the PA Turnpike I-276, take Exit 333/Norristown. Go through the toll booth and take the ramp for Plymouth Rd. Turn left on Plymouth Rd., then Right on Germantown Pike. Drive approx. 4 miles, then turn Left at the traffic light for Barley Sheaf Rd./North Wales Rd. Drive past the apartment complex on the left to enter the park. Then follow the park road past the main visitor lot and park office. Continue 1 mile to Lot #3. Follow signs for the pavilions.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION:

AVA Trail Rating – 1A

The trail is paved with minor inclines through agricultural fields and wooded areas. There is a small section of natural trail which is slightly rough and crosses a creek (this section can be bypassed). Trail also goes by trout nursery. Suitable for strollers wheelchairs.

NORRISTOWN FARM PARK

Norristown Farm Park represents a diverse history of farming, manufacturing and institutional associations. There are 15 historic buildings on the property, the earliest dating from 1794.

The property was originally owned by William Penn and was later transferred to Isaac Norris, namesake of Norristown, by way of William Penn's son in 1704.

Norristown State Hospital was opened in the 1870's as a mental hospital. It is a modern psychiatric hospital today. The park itself is on state owned land that surrounds the hospital.

It is still an actively farming park with eighty percent of the park dedicated to growing farm crops.

This event will be held regardless of weather conditions. There are no refunds. No littering. Pets are permitted but must be leashed and picked up after.
