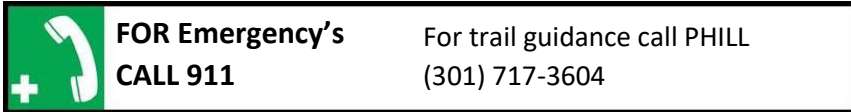

START/FINISH: High Ridge Park, 10100 Superior Ave., Laurel, MD 20723

TIMES: Start time is anytime between 9 a.m. and 12 noon and Finish by 3 p.m. **DISTANCE AND TRAILS:** 6km and 10km trails on natural surfaces, paved pathways and sidewalks of residential areas. Trail rated 2A. Additional challenge 2km optional segment (3B)

DESCRIPTION: 9-11 Commemorative Event-display will be at the Laurel, MD Avondale Riverfront Park. Walkers begin and finish in Howard County. They will span the Patuxent River and enter Prince George's County. 10 Km walkers further explore the Laurel Train station and take a brief excursion into Anne Arundel County. The challenge segment is a woods trail within High Ridge Park that includes walking along the Patuxent River. The Portlywalker has traversed every step.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Amphitheaters (10Km) Border Crossings 2 on 5 Km and 3 on 10 Km; Bridges Spanning the USA; Water Fountains (10Km) ; Points of Reference; Take a Walk in a City Park; USPO (10Km); Walking the Path of Inventors.

No pets are allowed in buildings/facilities; however, they are allowed on the trails. Owners must clean up after their pets.
