

**DIRECTIONS:**

From North:

- Take I97 South
- Or Route 2 South

From South:

- Route 2 North

From East or West:

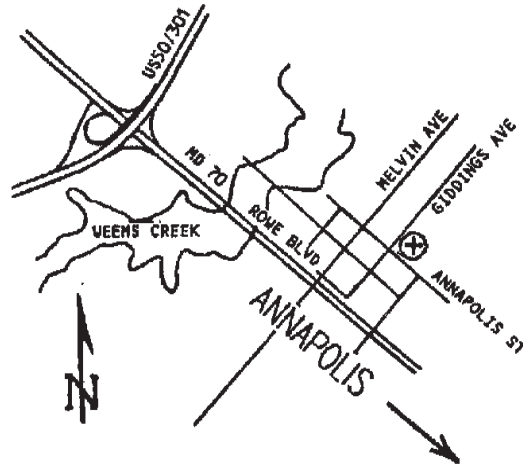
- Route 50 toward Annapolis

From Route 2 or I97, merge onto Route 50/301 East

- Take Exit #24 marked Route 70 South—Rowe Blvd.
- Take bridge over Weems Creek
- Turn left at first traffic light onto Melvin Avenue
- Drive two blocks to Annapolis Street (the street will be closed due to Oktoberfest activities)
- Parking is available on nearby streets or 3 blocks west of walk start/finish point at US Naval Academy Stadium off Rowe Blvd.
- Once parked, our booth will be at the corner of Annapolis St. and Taylor Ave.

**THEME:** The West Annapolis Oktoberfest begins at 12 noon with a variety of food, music and unique entertainment. The Volksmarch walk begins at 8 a.m.

**DATE:** Sunday, September 24, 2017

**SPONSOR:** Annapolis Amblers (AVA 595)

**TRAIL DESCRIPTION:** 5k and 10k trails with a trail rating of 1+. The trails will take you through some of the best that Annapolis has to offer. In addition you will walk is through the U.S. Naval Academy

**CONDITIONS:** The event will be conducted regardless of weather conditions.

**START/FINISH LOCATION:** Oktoberfest on Annapolis Street, West Annapolis. Amblers registration table can be found at the corner of Annapolis St. and Taylor Ave.

**START/FINISH TIME:** Register between 8 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. All participants must complete walk by 4 p.m.

**DISTANCE:** 10k (6.2 miles). Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. Runners joggers are advised to start early. A shorter 5k trail is also available.

**FEE/CREDIT:** The fee is \$3 to earn IVV credit and all walkers must carry a Start Card. No refunds. For no addition-

al fee, a participant may walk the trail twice in the same day to earn a distance credit of 20K.

**AWARDS:** Water Bottle Lanyard \$3.

**SPECIAL PROGRAMS:** Our Flag, US Post Office, Ports of Call, State Capital

**SANCTIONS:** The American Volkssport Association (AVA) and Maryland Volkssport Association, a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). Sanction number AT. 105055

**ELIGIBILITY:** Everyone is welcome to participate. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

**REFRESHMENTS:** Drinks and candy will be available at the registration table and at checkpoints along the route.

### What Is A Volksmarch?

A Volksmarch is “a walk of the people.” Participants are from the general public—moms, dads, children of all ages, grandparents, whole families.

Volksmarches are designed to appeal to everyone. Adequate time is allowed to complete the event at least once. The event is not a contest of speed or endurance. All who complete the event (at their own speed) are winners!

A bonus of Volkssporting events is the attractive awards. After completing the trail, participants have the opportunity to purchase awards to commemorate the walk.

In addition to collecting commemorative awards, anyone may enroll in the lifetime IVV Achievement Awards Program by purchasing an event and/or distance book to record your completion of the event. The book costs \$5.00 and entitles the owner to a certificate, hat pin, and patch upon completion of milestones.
