NEW Trails again this year ! There are 10 km and 6 km trails. Both trails will go on the campus of the Maryland School for the Deaf, passing the Hessian Barracks; into Mount Olivet Cemetery; and return through Historic Frederick and along Carroll Creek Park. These are on sidewalks and roadsides . The trails are user friendly to wagons, wheelchairs and strollers, though some difficulty may be encountered where there are no curb cuts.

Eligibility: We welcome everyone to walk with us. All participants must register and sign a waiver of liability. Each participant must carry a start card throughout the walk. Please return the card at the end of your walk so we know that you are safely off the trail. An adult must accompany children 12 and under throughout the entire walk. Parents of minor children must sign a waiver of liability for the children.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO VOLKSMARCH PARKING:

Via I-70 East: Take Exit 56 (East Patrick St.). Turn **RIGHT** at end of exit onto Rt. # 144. This will merge with East Patrick St. Continue on East Patrick St.

****** Turn LEFT** on Franklin St.; then **RIGHT** into parking lot, which is across from Gate 1 of Fairground. Park and walk across E. Patrick St. to Gate 1 of Fairground. Look straight ahead for our Volksmarch **START** table.

Via I-70 West: Take Exit 56 (East Patrick St.). Continue on East Patrick St. Follow from **** above.
