



**START/FINISH:** Saint Peter Catholic Church 800 East Grace Street Richmond, VA 23218. Please park in the church parking lot.

**START:** Start between 9:30 am and 12:30 pm.

**FINISH TIME:** 3:30 p.m.

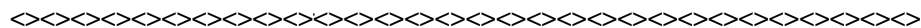
**DISTANCE:** 6 and 10k trail (3.7 & 6.2 miles). 10k Route can be repeated one time at no additional fee.

**TRAIL RATING:** Rated 2A – Some moderate hills (1 hard, short hill) or stair climbing and almost entirely on pavement for both the 6 and 10k. Hard for strollers, not advised for wheelchairs.

**AWARD:** There is an award for this walk - \$10 for award and walk. Credit only is \$3.00. Participants may walk for a “B” award for \$2 each. 20 awards will be available, there will be no reorder. There will be no refund of any monies paid.
