

Directions to the Days Inn Gettysburg:

From the North or South: Take US 15 to the York St (US-30) Exit. Follow US 30 West/York St towards Gettysburg for one mile to Days Inn. Located on the left side behind Perkins Restaurant.

From the East: Take US 30 West to Gettysburg. Cross US 15 and continue on US 30 West/York St one mile to Days Inn. Located on the left side behind Perkins Restaurant.

From the West: Take US 30 East to Gettysburg. Travel through Lincoln Square, continuing on US 30 East/Chambersburg St. Days Inn is on the right side, one mile east of Lincoln Square. Located on the right side behind Perkins Restaurant.

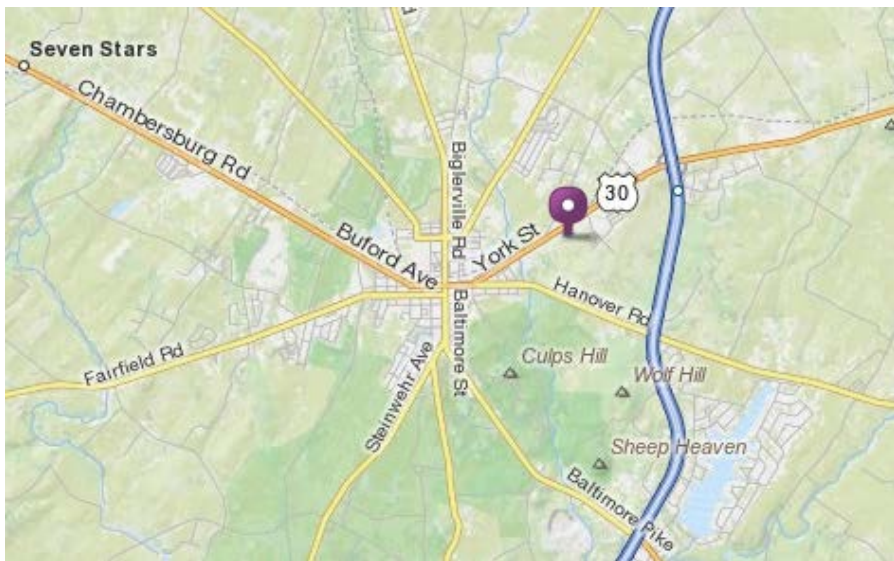
Directions to the YWCA of Gettysburg & Adams County:

From the square in Gettysburg go South on Baltimore St. (Bus.15 S, PA 116 W) 1 block to Middle St. Turn right on Middle St. (PA 116 W) and go 7/10 mile, passing traffic signals at Washington St., West St., and Confederate Ave./Seminary Ridge. The YWCA driveway is 1/10 mile past Confederate Ave. on the right.

Directions to the Adams County Winery:

From the square in Gettysburg, go west on Chambersburg St (US 30). In approximately 6 miles, veer left Old Route 30 towards McKnightstown. Drive 2 miles, turn left onto Orrtanna Rd, and follow the blue winery signs. There are well-marked signs for the Winery at this intersection and every turn you will make from here. In about one mile, you will come to another dead-end and stop sign. Turn right. At the fork in the road, keep to the left. In less than a mile, at the bottom of the hill, turn right on Peach Tree Road. In 1/3 mile, turn left and then proceed ¼ mile to the Winery.

Parking: There are large parking lots with free parking at all start locations.

DATES: Friday, November 10 – Sunday, November 12, 2017

SPONSOR: York White Rose Wanderers, AVA-236

SANCTIONED BY: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports. This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV Achievement awards.

PROCEDURE: AVA policy requires that every participant, fee or non-fee, sign the insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card, which is stamped at control points along the course. At the Finish, the validated card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the credit fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome to participate. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Walk at your own pace. Runners are welcome!

REGISTRATION and FEES: This event is free to those who wish to participate without IVV credit. IVV credit is \$3.00. IVV credit w/ "A" Award is \$7.00. There is no pre-registration. There will be no refunds.

CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of the weather. There will be no littering. Wildlife and plant life are not to be disturbed. No refunds. Pets must be on a leash at all times and are not permitted in any buildings. On Walk #1, participants with pets will have to detour around the Gettysburg National Cemetery.

AWARD: The "A" Award is a 1" hat pin which features a French Renault Tank. American Soldiers at Gettysburg's Camp Colt trained with these tanks during WW I. We have one hundred pins; there will not be a reorder.

RESTROOMS: Restrooms are available at the start and at least one other location on each 10K trail.

REFRESHMENTS: Water and hard candy will be available at the start/finish and checkpoints. For Walks #1, #2 and #3, food and beverage will be available for purchase at establishments along the trail. For Walk #4, the Adams County Winery will be selling food and drinks, including non-alcoholic beverages.

"Gettysburg in the Great War" - 2017 is the 100th Anniversary of the United States entering World War I. The War Department owned the Gettysburg battlefield at the time and they established Camp Colt in 1917 in the area where Pickett's Charge had occurred. Camp Colt opened in March 1918 with Captain Dwight D Eisenhower in charge. It was the first post to train American Soldiers to use tanks during World War I. This walk starts at the Weinbrenner Parking Area and will feature sites in Gettysburg associated with World War I.

Walk #3: AVA Event # AT17/106615 5K & 10K Trails, Rated 1A

"Stories of the Women"—It will start at Harrisburg Area Community College and will feature the women of Gettysburg. Confederate forces pushed the Union troops through the town and for four days, occupied Gettysburg. In addition to caring for their families, the women of Gettysburg hid Union troops who were unable to escape the advancing Confederates, fed the Soldiers, cared for the wounded, and buried the dead. Come learn their story!
