

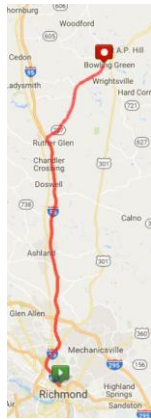

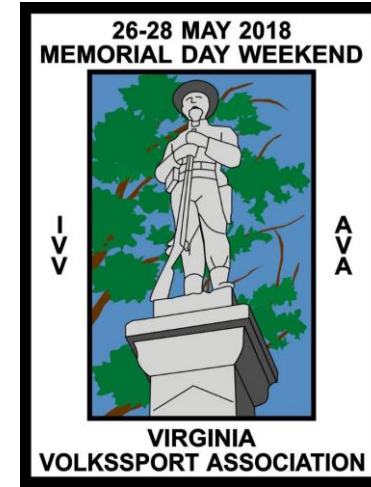

General Event Information

Sanctioned: All events in this brochure are sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). These events count toward the acquisition of IVV achievement awards.

Disclaimer: The American Volkssport Association or its subsidiary clubs are not responsible for theft or loss of personal belongings or property. All participants must sign a waiver.

Sponsor: Virginia Volkssport Association (AVA-VA)

Distances: 5 and 10 kilometers for all three events.

Start Times: All walks will start from 9 am until 1 pm; finish by 4 pm.

Eligibility: All are welcome. Everyone must register and sign the insurance waiver at the start, fill out and carry a start card, and turn it in upon completing the walk. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

Awards: There is one A Award (see picture on the front) for all events. The award is 5"x4". Fifteen of the award will be available and will be not be reordered. It celebrates Memorial Day with a statue found in Bowling Green.

Fees: There is no charge to participate. The cost of the award and credit will be \$9 for Pre-Registered, and \$10 after May 13, 2018. Credit only is \$3. There will be no refund of any monies paid.

Conditions: These events will be held regardless of most weather conditions. Carry water regardless of weather conditions. IVV Books and New Walker packets will be available for sale at all events. Pets are welcome on the trail, but not in the start points. Wheelchairs and strollers may be used on all trails.

Refreshments: Water and candy will be available at the start/finish and checkpoints. Restrooms will be available at all start points, but may not be available on the trail.

Year Rounds: There are several year round and seasonal events nearby that will help you fill out your day.

Saturday, 26 May 2017 – KING & QUEEN COUNTY

Start Point: Shackelfords Chapel United Methodist Church, 3727 Buena Vista Rd, Shackelfords, VA 23149. GPS: N37° 29' 48.3", W76° 40' 16.6"

Trail Description: Rated 1A: This walk will be along the shoulder of paved roads. There are no restrooms along the trail. The church is located in Plain View.

Directions: On I-64 between Richmond and Williamsburg, take the VA-33 exit, EXIT 220 toward West Point. Continue on VA-33 through West Point and over the bridges for about 13 miles. Turn right onto VA-14E through Cologne. Just past Route 644, arrive at the church on the left (cemetery on the right).

Qualifies for AVA Special Programs: Walking the USA - Street by Street (CO, GA, MI, MS, NM, PA, TN, TX, VA), Walking the USA A-Z. Also, qualifies for Virginia Counties program: King & Queen County.

Sunday, 27 May, 2018 – KING WILLIAM COUNTY

Start Point: McDonald's, 432 14th Street, West Point, VA. GPS: N37° 32' 13.0", W076° 47' 52.4"

Trail Description: Trail rating: 1A. This walk will be along town sidewalks and the shoulders of paved roads. One small section is on a bike path.

Directions: On I-64 between Richmond and Williamsburg, take the VA-33 exit, EXIT 220, toward West Point. Turn onto VA-33 for about 1 mile. Start point is on the right. Park on the left in the bank parking lot, not the McDonald's lot.

Qualifies for AVA Special Programs: Bridges, Points of Reference, Take a Walk in a City Park, U S Post Offices, Walking the USA - Street by Street (AL, AR, CT, FL, IL, IA, ME, MA, MI, MS, MO, MT, NH, NY, ND, OH, OK, PA, SD, TX, UT, VT, WV, WY), Walking America's Ports of Call, Walking the USA A-Z. Also, qualifies for Virginia Counties program: King William County.

Monday, 28 May 2018 - CAROLINE COUNTY

Start Point: Subway, 219 Anderson Ave, Bowling Green, VA. GPS: N38° 02' 52.8", W077° 21' 30.8"

Trail Description: Trail rating: 1A. The walk will be along town sidewalks and the shoulders of paved roads.

Directions: On I-95 between Richmond and Fredericksburg, take EXIT 104 on VA 207 E toward Bowling Green. After 11 miles, turn left on VA 207 Bus E for 0.7 miles. Turn left just before McDonald's into the shopping center. Subway is on the left. Park in the back of the parking lot.

Qualifies for AVA Special Programs: Bridges, United States Post Offices, Walking the USA Street by Street (AK, CA, CT, DE, FL, GA, IL, IN, IA, KS, KY, LA, ME, MA, MD, MI, MS, MO, MT, NE, NH, NJ, NY, NC, ND, OH, PA, SC, SD, TN, TX, UT, VA). Also, qualifies for Virginia Counties program: Caroline County.
