

Directions to Start/Finish: From I295 or I95, take the Rt. 32 exit toward Ft Meade, then exit right on the 1st Odenton exit/Rt. 175. At the 3rd traffic light (Piney Orchard Parkway/Telegraph Rd/Rt. 170), turn right and travel 2 miles to a traffic circle called **The Roundabout**. Take the 3rd exit to enter the shopping center, and park on either side of the main entrance road. Walk between the buildings towards the Community Center, which is right behind the shopping center; the festival takes place in front of the center, on Stream Valley Drive, but there will be very little parking on that street.

From Annapolis, take I97 north to Rt. 32 towards Odenton. Take the 2nd Odenton exit (Rt. 170) and turn left for 2.5 miles on Telegraph Rd, which becomes Piney Orchard Parkway. Proceed about 2 miles to **The Roundabout** traffic circle and follow the instructions above.

For parking at the elementary school, continue on Piney Orchard Parkway past Stream Valley Drive, past **The Roundabout**, to the light at Strawberry Lake Way. Turn left for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. The school and parking lot will be on your right. Stream Valley Drive ends at the school. Walk up Stream Valley Drive 2 blocks and look for the Amblers sign.

DATE: Saturday, June 9, 2018

SPONSOR: The Annapolis Amblers

START/FINISH: Start anytime between 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM. All walkers must finish by 4:00 PM.

LOCATION: 2400 Stream Valley Dr. Odenton, MD 21113. Look for the Annapolis Amblers booth and the AVA banner, either in the Community Center parking lot or on Stream Valley Drive (we don't know which spot we'll be assigned to!).

REGISTRATION: Everyone is welcome to participate. Each walker must register at the start by filling out a start card to be carried throughout the walk. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult during the walk.

FEES: There is no charge to participate in this event. The fee for IVV credit is \$3.00.

AWARD: IVV Credit only.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: 10K trail rating: 1+, 5K trail rating 1. The 10K walk will take you through many neighborhoods, a few small hills, and dip into the Nature Preserve for some natural path walking and possible wildlife viewing. The 5K walk will be all paved sidewalks or paved trails.

AMENITIES: Water and candy will be available at the start/finish. Portable toilets will be available in several areas at the start/finish, or use restrooms in the shopping center. Strollers: Medium on the 10K trail, easy on the 5K. Wheelchairs: Medium on the 5K only—not recommended for the 10K. Pets: Yes, if leashed and cleaned up after.
