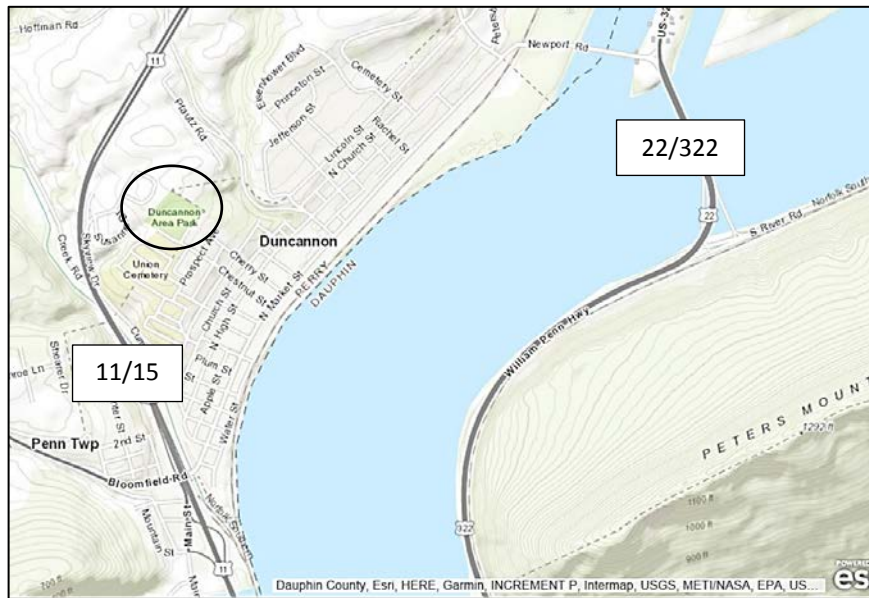


DIRECTIONS TO START POINT: 40.3967, -77.0315

From the East or West: Use Rte. 22/322, Take Exit 849 West Duncannon, continue Straight on N. Market Street, turn Right onto Chestnut Street, follow up the hill to the end, turn Right into the parking lot.

From the North: Use Rte. 11/15, Take Exit 274 West Duncannon, turn Left onto S. Market Street (under bridge), turn Left onto Chestnut Street, follow up the hill to the end, turn Right into the parking lot.

From the South: Use Rte. 11/15, take Exit 274 West Duncannon, turn Right onto S. Main Street, turn Right onto S. Market Street (under bridge), turn Left onto Chestnut Street, follow up the hill to the end, turn Right into the parking lot.



PARKING: Duncannon Area Park has free parking and the streets near the festival have free parking.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The trail is on sidewalks, along a portion of roadway, and on cemetery roads. You will travel down a hill into town, around town, through the AT Community Festival and then back up the hill. Both distances will be on the Appalachian Trail in Duncannon Borough and go to the festival.

The trail is not recommended for wheelchairs, but strollers should have little problem with the hills. Some sidewalks do not have curb cuts.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Appalachian Trail in 14 States, AT thru Hike in PA, Bridges – Spanning the USA, Ice Cream Parlors, Take A Walk in a City Park, United States Post Office, Walk the USA – Street by Street, Pa County – Perry,

PROCEDURES: All participants must register and complete a Start Card, which is carried on the walk, and must be returned at the Finish. This also applies to free walkers. There is no pre-registration.

FEES: This is a **Credit Only** event. **IVV Credit is \$3.00.** This event is Free to those who wish to participate without receiving IVV credit. Children 12 and under will not be charged for IVV credit.

AWARDS: Awards from past events in Duncannon will be available for purchase at the event at “B Award” costs.

ELIGIBILITY: The event is open to the public. You do not need to be a member of the Susquehanna Rovers to participate. Adult supervision is required for all children.

CONDITIONS: This event will be held regardless of weather conditions. There are no refunds. Pets are permitted but must be leashed and cleaned up after.

FACILITIES: A porta-john will be available at the Start/Finish. Water will be available at the Start/Finish and at the Checkpoint. Food will be available for purchase in the festival area.
