
301 S. Route 15, Dillsburg, PA 17019

From York, PA take Rt. 74 through Dover to Rossville (5 mi.) Go straight at the signal light in Rossville onto Old York Rd for 7 mi. to Dillsburg. As soon as you enter the town, passing a school ballfield on left, turn left onto York St. Cross over Baltimore St. and turn left onto Second St. Go a short distance to turn Right on Gettysburg St. Turn right on Chalet Ave. Turn left into parking lot to the back of the American Legion (large white bldg.) Start Point is on the right side of the bldg. marked Ballroom entrance.

<u>From the North</u>- Take Rt. 15 S going through Dillsburg to the south end of town. You will pass the American Legion on the left. Go to the next crossover and turn left onto Golf Course Road and then immediately left again on Gettysburg St. At Chalet Ave. turn left and enter the parking lot at the back of the Legion. Start point on the right side (Ballroom entrance).

From the south Take Rt. 15 N to the south end of Dillsburg. Turn right onto Golf Course Rd. and immediately turn left on Gettysburg St. At Chalet Ave. turn left and enter American Legion parking lot.

DATE: Saturday and Sunday, August 4 & 5, 2018

START AREA: Dillsburg American Legion Post 26 301 S. Route 15, Dillsburg, PA 17019 Free parking is available. **START/FINISH TIME:** 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 Noon. Finish by 4:00 p.m.

PROCEDURE: AVA policy requires that every participant, **fee** or nonfee, sign the insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card which is stamped at control points along the course. At the Finish, the validated card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the credit fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome to participate. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Walk at your own pace.

FEES and CREDIT: This event is FREE to those who wish to participate without IVV credit. IVV credit is \$3.00. No Refunds Will Be Given. New Walker packets (a \$30+ value) will be available for those wishing to begin walking for credit.

AWARD: There will be no special award for this event. IVV Credit only.

<u>CONDITIONS:</u> The event will be held regardless of the weather. There will be no littering. Wildlife and plant life are not to be disturbed. No refunds. Pets must be on a leash at all times and are not permitted in any buildings. Please clean up after your pet.

PARKING: Available at Start Area.

REFRESHMENTS AND RESTROOMS: Walkers can buy lunch or dinner at the American Legion. Water will be available at the Start/Finish and Check Points. Restrooms are available at the Start and a few places along the trail.

COMMENTS: This Dillsburg Walk is a memorial walk for John McCoy (1/20/41 - 11/24/16) who originally laid out the trails for this walk in the summer of 2006. The walk directions are John's, with very few changes. John was a very active member of YWRW from 2001 to 2016. He was our newsletter editor for several years, our trail master for walks in Hanover, New Freedom, Naylor's Winery, Fawn Grove, Keystone Games, York Winter Walk, and Dillsburg. He also organized 11 bus trips, taking us to places like Niagara Falls, West Point and Mystic Seaport, Williamsburg, Watkins Glen, Cleveland, and Bristol, VA/TN. He also organized many bus trips to all parts of PA, so walkers could walk in PA counties that had no traditional walks in them. John and his wife, Betty, walked in all 67 counties of PA, all 50 United States, most of Europe, and several provinces of Canada.

TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS: Both 5K and 10K trails are mainly on sidewalks throughout the historic town of Dillsburg. Due to the lack of curb cuts at several intersections, it will be difficult for strollers and wheelchairs. Dillsburg, which is nestled in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains, was named for Matthew Dill who settled here in 1740. It was incorporated in April 9, 1833.
