



Start Point:

Middle Creek Wildlife Management Area
 Willow Point Pavilion
 Hopeland Road
 Stevens, PA 17578.
 GPS: 40°16'54.0"N 76°14'32.1"W

Directions to Start Point:

From Eastern PA: Take the PA Turnpike to Exit 286. Take Rte 272 North for three miles, and at the traffic light, turn left on Rte 897. Follow Rte 897 North for about 14 miles into the village of Kleinfeltersville. In Kleinfeltersville make the first left after the stop sign (Hopeland Rd). The Willow Point Parking Lot will be on the left after passing Sunnyside Rd and T307.

From Central PA: Take the PA Turnpike to Exit 266. Take Rte 72 North (about 4-5 Miles to Rte 419 North. Follow Rte 419 North for approximately 7 miles to Rte 897 in Shaefferstown. * follow Rte 897 South for about 2 miles to Kleinfeltersville. Turn right at Hopeland Rd in Kleinfeltersville. The Willow Point Parking Lot will be on the left after passing Sunnyside Rd and T307.

From SouthCentral PA - York, Hanover, Harrisburg, Gettysburg, etc.: Rte 30 EAST to Rte 501 North Exit Rte 501 NORTH to Shaefferstown. Turn Right on Rte 897 and follow directions above after the *.

DATE: Sunday, September 23, 2018

SPONSOR: Penn Dutch Pacers AVA 0579

START TIMES: 8:00 AM – 1:00 PM, finish by 4:00 PM

START POINT: Middle Creek Wildlife Management Area Willow Point, Hopeland Road (GPS 40°16'54.0"N 76°14'32.1"W) north of the visitor center (which is located at 100 Museum Road, Stevens PA 17578).

SANCTIONED BY: The American Volkssporting Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports, sanctions this event. This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV Achievement awards.

PROCEDURE: AVA policy requires that every participant, fee or non-fee, sign the insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card which is stamped at control points along the course. At the Finish, the validated card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the credit fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome to participate. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Walk at your own pace. Runners are welcome!

REGISTRATION and FEES: This event is free to those who wish to participate without IVV credit. IVV credit is \$3.00. Award and Credit \$8.00

CONDITIONS: The event will be held regardless of the weather. There will be no littering. Wildlife and plant life are not to be disturbed. No refunds. Pets must be on a leash at all times and are not permitted in any buildings. Please clean up after your pet.

REFRESHMENTS: Water provided at the start and at the checkpoints

AMENITIES: *Strollers: Easy-7K, difficult- 11K, Wheelchairs: Easy-7K, No-11K, Pets: Yes (except inside Start Point), Restrooms: Yes (at checkpoint. Port-a-Jon at start point)*

TRAIL DESCRIPTION: The 7K (6.5k) is an out and back (mostly flat) from Willow Point (a peninsula into the Middle Creek Wildlife Management Area's lake to the Visitor Center. The 11 K will include the Conservation and Spice Bush Trails through the fields and woods near the visitor center in addition to the 7K route. The exhibits for National Hunting and Fishing Day will be in and around the Visitor Center. The distance from the Willow Point parking lot to the Willow Point Pavilion is included in the stated route lengths.

COMMENTS: While Pets are welcome on the walk, they will not be able to enter the start point. There will be one checkpoint on the 7K, and that same checkpoint will be passed twice on the 11K). There are restrooms at the visitor center and a port-a-john at the Willow Point.
