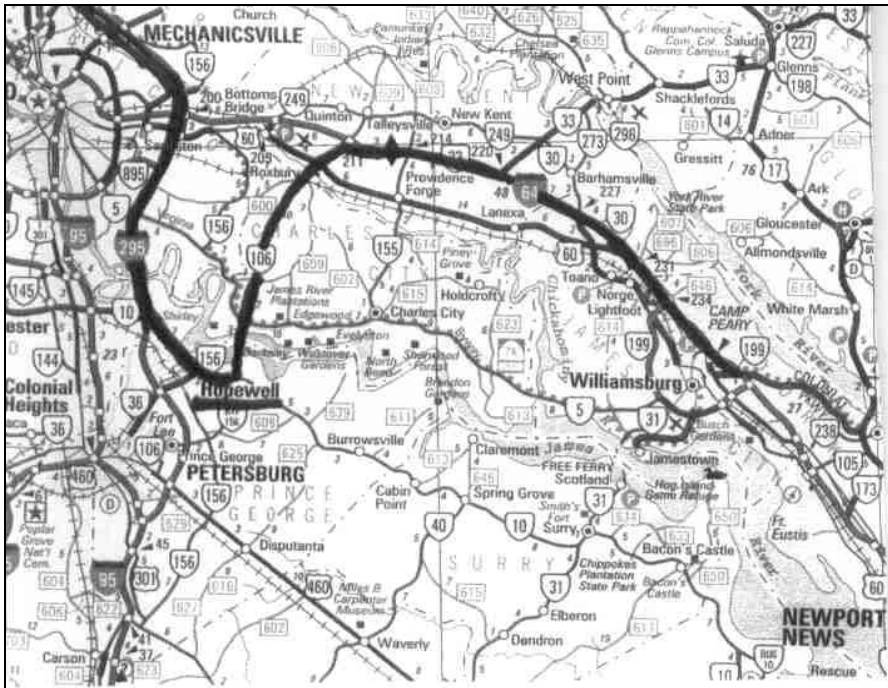


DIRECTIONS TO HOPEWELL, VIRGINIA

FROM I-95S: Take I-295 S to Exit # 15A, Route 10 East toward Hopewell. Route 10 becomes Randolph Road after crossing the Appomattox River Bridge. Continue on Randolph Road past John Randolph Hospital (on the left) and through two more traffic lights to Hardee's on the right, just before the underpass. Those coming from the Portsmouth/Chesapeake/Virginia Beach area might find traveling on Route 460 or Route 5 to be a more direct route.

I-64W: Take exit 211, Route 156. Continue, crossing Route 60. Right at light onto Route 10. Continue through several traffic lights. Immediately after the railroad underpass, turn left onto City Point Road, Hardee's is on the right.

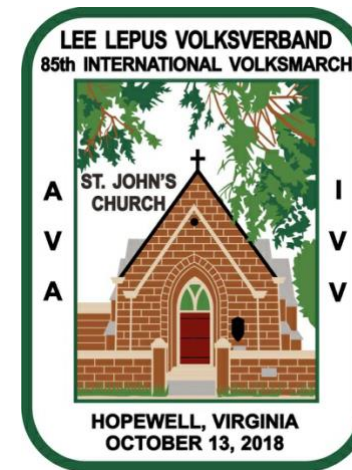

TRAIL RATING 2-B



START/FINISH: Hardee's Restaurant, 310 W. Randolph Road, Hopewell, VA (THANK YOU, HARDEE'S) Additional parking is available in city parking lot next door.

START: Start between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

FINISH TIME: 4:00 p.m.

DISTANCE: 5 and 10 KM trail (3.1 & 6.2 miles). 10 KM route can be repeated one time at no additional fee.

TRAIL RATING: Rated 2-B; Very small hills or very little stair climbing, mostly on pavement except along the Appomattox River. Difficult for strollers, not suitable for wheelchairs along Appomattox River (unpaved) and some brick streets.

AWARD: Award is a 100 % embroidered patch depicting St John's Church; the basement was a stop on the Underground Railroad.

SANCTIONED: This event is sanctioned by American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV).

IVV BOOKS: This event counts toward acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards. IVV event/distance books and new walker packets are available at the finish point at a cost of \$6.00 each.

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to all; everyone is welcome. An adult must accompany children under the age of twelve.
