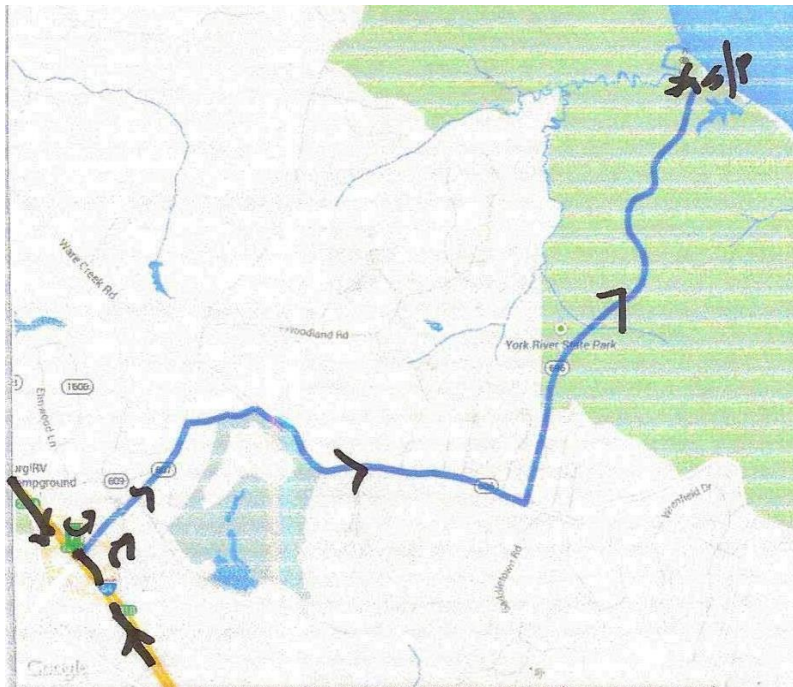


DIRECTIONS FOR YORK RIVER STATE PARK::

From I-64, take the Croaker Exit 231B. Go north on Route 607 (Croaker Rd.) for one mile, then right on Route 606 (Riverview Rd.) for about one and a half miles to the park entrance. Take a left turn into the park. Stop at the Contact Station and pay your entrance fee (\$3 during the week and \$4 on weekends. Drive to the end of the road at the Visitors Center. Box is located by the table to the left in the Museum portion of the Visitors Center.

SANCTIONED EVENT

Eligible for credit toward IVV Achievement Awards



SANCTION: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). This event counts for acquisition of IVV achievement awards.

SPONSOR: Virginia Vagabonds (AVA 365)

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone! Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Groups are welcome.

FEES: There is an A Award for York River State Park at a cost of \$10.00. The award is 4 x 4 patch and is the same A Award for all state parks in Virginia in 2017. 20 patches are available and there will be no reorder. IVV Credit Only Fee is \$3.00 each event. There is no fee just to participate, but you must carry a start card. No refunds.

IVV CREDIT: You may enter event credit for each day that you walk the trail into your IVV event book. You may participate for DISTANCE credit WITHOUT LIMIT. All participants of IVV events are reminded to bring their IVV books to this event. There are insert cards in the box.

DISTANCE: There is one 5-kilometer (3.1 mile) trail and one 10-kilometer (6.2 mile) trail. The 10-kilometer walk may be completed a second time for credit at no additional fee.

CONDITIONS: Pets are permitted on this event; however, they must be on a 6-foot leash. Litter must be deposited in the designated containers. Water and restrooms are available at the start point and at the 5-kilometer point.

START POINT: York River State Park Visitors Center, 9801 York River Park Rd, Williamsburg, VA. GPS: N37° 23.8231', W076° 43.4738'

START AND FINISH TIMES: The start point is open daily from 8 a.m. to dusk. The events must be walked during daylight hours.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: The walk will be on sidewalks and trails in York River State Park. The trail is suitable for strollers, but not wheelchairs. Trail Rating: 2B.
