

SANCTION: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). This event counts for acquisition of IVV achievement awards.

SPONSOR: The Wood & Dale Wanderers

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone! Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Groups are welcome. Children over 16 could be pressed into service in the Marine Corps if left unattended.

AWARD/FEES: IVV Credit Only Fee: \$3.00 each event. There is no fee just to participate, but you must carry a start card. The museum and park do not charge for admission. No refunds. Please buy all your Marine Corps souvenirs in the museum gift shop to remember this event.

IVV CREDIT: You may enter ONE event credit for each day that you walk the trail into your IVV event book. You may participate for DISTANCE credit WITHOUT LIMIT. All participants of IVV events are reminded to bring their IVV books to this event. There will be insert cards in the box if you need them.

PROCEDURES: At the start point, each participant will register in the log book and get their own start card, which must be signed and carried along the trail. The individual start cards will be mailed in after completing the event.

CONDITIONS: Pets are permitted on the trail BUT NOT IN THE MUSEUM; however, they must be on a leash. No pets will be allowed in the start point. Water and restrooms are available at the start points, and in the park. There is no water available along the trail, so you should carry water with you. Litter must be deposited in designated containers. All walks must be completed during daylight hours during the time the museum is open.

START POINT: Information desk, National Museum of the Marine Corps, 18900 Jefferson Davis Highway, Triangle, VA 22172

GPS Coordinates: (WARNING: This is classified from the Russians!)
N38° 32.6432', W077° 20.5947'

DISTANCE: There is one 6-kilometer (3.7 miles) trail, a 10-kilometer (6.2 miles) trail, and a 20-kilometer (12.4 miles) trail option to this walk. The 10-kilometer walk may be completed a second time for credit at no additional fee.

START AND FINISH TIMES: The museum is open from 9 am to 5 pm daily except Christmas.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: The walk trail will be primarily along paved paths around the museum and on Locust Shade county park nature trails and park roads, while the 20-kilometer option is along urban route. The trail may not be suitable for strollers and the handicapped without assistance. Trail Rating: 1B.

DIRECTIONS: Take I-95 until you see a very tall silver structure immediately on the east of the highway. That is Exit 150. You are now 36 miles south of Washington, D.C., and 76 miles north of Richmond, VA. From I-95 heading south, take Exit 150A to Route 1 (Jefferson Davis Highway); turn right (south) onto Route 1; travel approximately ¼ mile; the Museum's entrance is on the right. From I-95 heading north, take Exit 150 (Jefferson Davis Highway); turn right (south) onto Route 1; travel approximately ¼ mile; the Museum's entrance is on the right. There is no charge for parking at the Museum. Museum parking for handicapped visitors and oversized vehicles is available.
