

Directions to College Park Airport Operations Building
(38.979545, -76.922732)
1909 Corporal Frank Scott Drive, College Park, MD 20740

From 495/95: Take Exit 23 to MD 201 S/Hwy 201S/Kenilworth Ave. towards Greenbelt. Turn right onto Campus Drive. Turn right on Corporal Frank Scott Drive. Drive to end into College Park Airport and straight into parking lot*

From Route 1 Heading South. Turn left onto Campus Drive. Turn left onto Corporal Frank Scott Drive end into College Park Airport and straight into parking lot*.

From Route 1 Heading North. Turn right onto Campus Drive. Turn left onto Corporal Frank Scott Drive end into College Park Airport and straight into parking lot*.

From College Park Metro Exit toward parking garage, bear left on sidewalk around parking garage to traffic light at River Road and Campus Drive. Cross River Road straight on right side of Campus Drive to the next light at 51st Avenue/Corporal Frank Scott Drive. Cross Campus Drive walk down Corporal Frank Scott Drive to end into parking lot for airport. Operations building is on your right,

*Park in lot for Operations Building any spot marked for Airport Business. Please do not park in parking lot for Airport Museum.

Start Time: Start between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. and finish
by 4:00 p.m.

Trails: 5 and 10k trails are both rated 2A: The walks start at the new operations building at the College Park Airport. When entering be sure to look for the art work celebrating the Wright Brothers and their training of military pilots at the airport. The 5/10k trails view the airport from the new observation deck. Walk through two historic neighborhoods Lakeland and Berwyn. Lakeland planned as an exclusive resort community in 1890 near the then much smaller Lake Artemesia and B&O Railroad. Berwyn exemplifies the transformation of College Park from a semi-rural community to a middle-class commuter suburb of Washington DC. Note for wheelchairs and strollers part of the trail is on flat gravel paths.

Amenities: Water, candy and restrooms available at the Start/Finish and midpoint. Please carry water.

Eligibility: We welcome everyone to walk with us.

Registration: Our walk is free. IVV credit is \$3.00. Children under 12 may earn IVV credit for no charge at all events sponsored by the Great Greenbelt Volksmarch Club. New walker packets will be available for \$5.00 and Event Books for \$6.00.

Greenbelt VC Coupons are welcome payment for this event. Greenbelt sells 12 coupons for \$30. You can use the coupons for all Greenbelt events, regular, seasonal and year-rounds.

AVA Special Programs: Bridges, Spanning the USA, Take a Walk in a City Park, Walking the Path of Invention

Membership: Membership in the Great Greenbelt Volksmarchers is open to everyone interested in fitness, fun, and fellowship. Members are encouraged to help with events and other club activities. Dues are \$10.00 per year.

Sanctioned by: The Maryland Volkssport Association (MVA) and the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports. This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards.

Procedure: AVA policy requires that every participant, fee or non-fee, sign the insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card. At the finish, the validated card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the credit fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

Conditions: Pets are not allowed in the start point. They are allowed on the trails but must be leashed at all times during the walk. This walk will be held, unless PG County has travel advisories in effect. If inclement weather, please check with contact person or our Facebook Page for update information.
