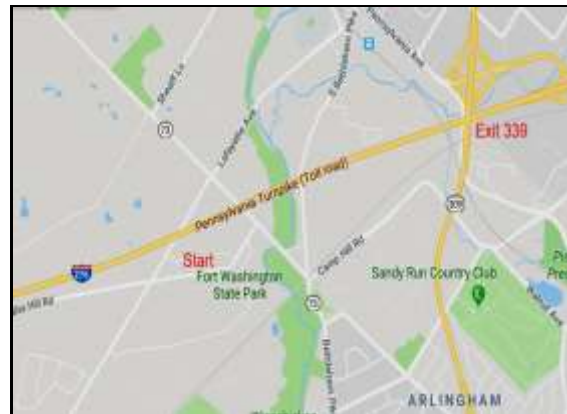
PICNIC

The Start Point is best reached from Joshua Rd. and not the park's main entrance nor the official address which is the park office. Follow the directions below.

From the PA Turnpike I-276, take Exit 339 for Philadelphia/Ambler. Go through the toll booth and past the PA-309 S ramp. Continue straight onto Pennsylvania Ave. Drive 0.7 miles and turn left on Bethlehem Pike. Turn right on Skippack Pike/PA-73 (MaGerks Pub on the corner). After a short distance, go past the main entrance to the park then continue 0.25 miles to the light at Joshua Rd. Turn left on Joshua Rd. Cross Militia Hill Rd., then continue 0.25 miles to State Park Rd. Turn left on State Park Rd., then a quick right at the triangle following signs for Lot #1. Pavilion will be on the left. Also look for LBW road signs which will be posted along the way.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION:

AVA Trail Rating – 2B

The trail is on paved and grass covered surfaces with minor inclines. It also follows a picturesque footpath along the Wissahickon Creek. One of the highlights is the Hawk Observation Deck where 16 species of raptors that migrate on the East Coast can be seen from September thru October.

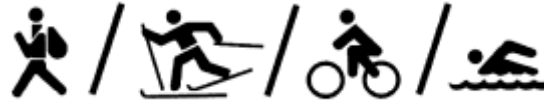
Difficult for strollers and wheelchairs.

HISTORY:

The park and community of Fort Washington take their name from the fort built there by soldiers of the American Revolution in the fall of 1777. There were 12,000 men of Gen. George Washington's army encamped there Nov. 2, 1777. Because of Washington's strong position, only local skirmishes with the British took place. The Continental Army left there on Dec. 11 and marched to Valley Forge for the courageous over-winter encampment.
