

SANCTION: These events are sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). These events count for acquisition of IVV achievement awards.

SPONSOR: Virginia Vagabonds (AVA 365)

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone! Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Groups are welcome.

AWARD/FEES: IVV Credit Only Fee: \$3.00 each event. There is no fee just to participate, but you must carry a start card. Award will be mailed. No refunds. There will be no refunds of any monies paid.

IVV CREDIT: You may enter event credit for each day that you walk the trail into your IVV event book for the trail. You may participate for DISTANCE credit WITHOUT LIMIT. All participants of IVV events are reminded to bring their IVV books to this event. There will be insert cards in the box if you need them.

PROCEDURES: At the start point, each participant will register in the log book and get their own start card, which must be signed and carried along the trail. The individual start cards will be mailed in after completing the event.

CONDITIONS: Pets are permitted on these; however, they must be on a 6-foot leash. No pets will be allowed in the start points. Water and restrooms are available at the start points. There is no water available along the trail, so you should carry water with you. Litter must be deposited in designated containers. All walks must be completed during daylight hours.

**JAMESTOWNE GLASSHOUSE
COLONIAL NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK**
Event number AT 19-Y2273

START POINT: Jamestowne Glasshouse, 1355 Colonial Pkwy, Williamsburg, VA. GPS: N37° 14.9146', W076° 42.0124'

DISTANCE: There is one 5-kilometer (3.1 mile) trail and one 10-kilometer (6.2 mile) trail. The 10-kilometer walk may be completed a second time for credit at no additional fee.

START AND FINISH TIMES: 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Walk will be primarily along the Virginia Capital and Greensprings Greenway Trail. These trails are partially natural surface and asphalt pavement with some small hills. The Greensprings Greenway Trail has a nature trail, with information signs about the history of the area. The trail is suitable for wheelchairs, strollers, and wagons. Trail Rating: 1B.

DIRECTIONS: Take I-64 towards Williamsburg to Exit 242A, Route 199 West. Drive above 3.4 miles to the second stoplight. At the second stoplight, turn right onto S. Henry Street (Route 132). Immediately turn right again and at the bottom of the ramp turn right onto the Colonial Parkway towards Jamestowne. Continue on the parkway approximately 7.4 miles until you come to the right turn to the Glasshouse located in the Jamestowne portion of the Colonial National Historical Park. The sign at this corner says: "Glassblowing—The 1355 Colonial Pkwy, Williamsburg, VA. Glasshouse of 1608". Park at the parking lot and walk down the path to the left of the parking lot to the Glasshouse. Ask for the walk box at the cash register.

**POQUOSON DINER
POQUOSON, VIRGINIA**

START POINT: Poquoson Diner, 480 Wythe Creek Road, Poquoson, Virginia, GPS Coordinates: N37° 7.6166', W076° 23.477'

DISTANCE: There is one 6-kilometer (3.7 mile) trail and one 10-kilometer (6.2 mile) trail. The 10-kilometer walk may be completed a second time for credit at no additional fee.

START AND FINISH TIMES: Start point is open from 7 am to 9 pm Monday thru Saturday and from 7 am to 3 pm on Sundays. Closed on Christmas Day.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Walk will be on sidewalks and shoulders of road through the City of Poquoson. A small portion will be on the Oxford Run Trail. The trail is suitable for strollers and wagons and the handicapped without assistance. Trail Rating: 1B.

DIRECTIONS: From North and West: Take I-64 East to Hampton and exit at Exit 256B, Victory Boulevard. At the top of the ramp, turn right and follow Victory Boulevard approximately 5.2 miles (through eight traffic lights). At McDonalds on the right, turn left on Wythe Creek Road. The diner is on the right just past the strip mall. Park in the strip mall parking lot.

From Norfolk And Hampton: Take I-64 West to Exit 262 (Magruder Boulevard). Follow Magruder Boulevard approximately 3.1 miles. At the fifth traffic light, turn right on Commander Shepard Boulevard (McDonalds is on right and Hardees is on the left shortly after this turn). At the next light, turn left onto Wythe Creek Road. Follow this for approximately 2.1 miles, passing NASA, and entering Poquoson. At the third traffic light, just past McDonalds, continue straight on Wythe Creek Road. The diner is on the right just past the strip mall. Park in the strip mall parking lot.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Take a Walk In a City Park, United States Post Offices, Walk the USA - Street by Street (AR, FL, IA, IN, KY, NM, NV, NY, OH, TX, VA), Walking the USA A - Z , Virginia City Program - Poquoson

NEWPORT NEWS PARK

START POINT: Campground Office, Newport News Park, 13564 Jefferson Avenue, Newport News, Virginia. GPS Coordinates: N37° 10.8531', W076° 33.1961'

DISTANCE: There is one 6-kilometer (3.7 mile) trail and one 10-kilometer (6.2 mile) trail. The 10-kilometer walk may be completed a second time for credit at no additional fee.

START AND FINISH TIMES: The Campground Office is open from 7 am to 9 pm daily

COURSE DESCRIPTION: The walk trail will be primarily along park nature trails and park roads. The trail may not be suitable for strollers, wagons, and the handicapped without assistance. Trail Rating: 1B.

DIRECTIONS: Take I-64 to Exit 250B. Turn left at traffic light onto VA Route 143W (Jefferson Ave). Follow Route 143W approximately 1.2 miles to the Newport News Park Campground at Campsite Drive. Turn right into the campground. At the 25 mph traffic sign, turn right into the parking lot. The start is in the campground office, which is located right beside the parking lot.
