

Directions to Gettysburg Recreation Park 545 Long Ln, Gettysburg, PA 17325

The American Legion Pavilion is to the right of the Charlie Sterner Recreation Building.

FROM THE SOUTH (Frederick, MD)

- From US-15N, take Exit 1 in Pennsylvania and follow US-15 Business/Emmitsburg Rd into Gettysburg.
- Turn left onto Queen St.
- At the "T" intersection, turn right onto Long Lane.
- The Gettysburg Rec Park will be on the left.

FROM THE WEST (Chambersburg, PA):

- Take US-30 East/Chambersburg Pike/Buford Ave into Gettysburg where it becomes Chambersburg St.
- Turn right onto S. Franklin St.
- Turn right onto Breckenridge St and then immediately turn left onto Long Lane.
- The Gettysburg Recreation Park will be on the right.

FROM THE NORTH (Harrisburg, PA)

- From US-15 South, take the exit for US-30.
- Turn right onto York Rd (quickly becomes York St).
- Go through the Square and turn left onto S. Franklin St.
- Turn right onto Breckenridge St and then immediately turn left onto Long Lane.
- Gettysburg Rec Park will be on the right.

FROM THE EAST (York, PA)

- Take US-30 West and cross US-15. US-30W is now York St.
- Turn right onto York Rd (quickly becomes York St).
- Go through the Square and turn left onto S. Franklin St.
- Turn right onto Breckenridge St and then immediately turn left onto Long Lane.
- Gettysburg Rec Park will be on the right.

START AREA: American Legion Pavilion, Gettysburg Rec Park, 545 Long Lane, Gettysburg, PA 17325 Free parking is available.

START/FINISH TIME: Start 9 am - 1 pm (10K) 2 pm (5K); finish by 4 pm. The 5K Town Guided Walk will start at 9:30 am. The 5K Battlefield Guided Walk will start at 2 pm.

SANCTIONED BY: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports. This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards.

PROCEDURE: AVA policy requires that every participant, fee or non-fee, sign the insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card which is stamped at control points along the course. At the Finish, the validated card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the credit fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome to participate. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Walk at your own pace.

FEES and CREDIT: This event is free to those who wish to participate without IVV credit. IVV credit is \$3.00. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN. There will be no special award for this event.

DISCLAIMER: The American Volkssport Association or its subsidiary clubs are not responsible for theft or loss of personal belongings or property Reasonable effort will be made by the sponsors to make this a safe, enjoyable and memorable event.

CONDITIONS: Pets must be on a leash at all times and are not permitted in any buildings. Please clean up after your pet.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: Ice Cream Parlors, Little Free Libraries, National Parks Centennial Challenge, Take a Walk in a City Park, Underground Railroad, Vice Presidential Walks

REFRESHMENTS AND RESTROOMS: Water and hard candy will be available at the Start. Restrooms are available at the start.

TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS: The walk consists of two 5K Loops. Either loop may be done for 5K credit; both loops must be done for 10K credit. A Guided Walk will be offered for each 5K loop. Participants are not required to participate in the Guided Walk; you may walk on your own. Each Guided Walk will take about two hours. The 5K Town Guided Walk will start at 9:30 am and will feature the southern end of the town of Gettysburg. The 5K Battlefield Guided Walk will start at 2 pm and will feature the National Cemetery and the "Highwater Mark" area which is where Pickett's Charge occurred. Pets are not allowed on either guided walk.

YEAR ROUND EVENTS: There are three Year Round Walks, a Bike, and a Swim in Gettysburg. The start box for all events is at the Gettysburg YWCA. Walk #2 and the bike pass the Gettysburg Rec Park. You will be able to register for Walk #2 and the Bike and start from the Gettysburg Rec Park.
