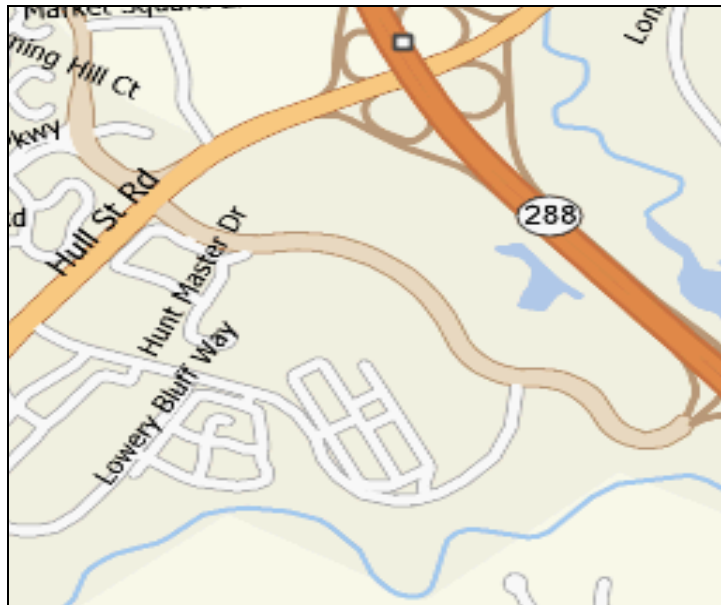


**DIRECTIONS TO SUNDAY PARK, BRANDERMILL**  
**MIDLOTHIAN, VIRGINIA**

**FROM I-95:** take exit 62 onto Route 288. Drive 13 miles, exit at Hull Street Road, West (towards Amelia) Turn right at first light onto Old Hundred Road into Brandermill. Turn left at first road, Millridge Parkway. Continue ½ mile to Sunday Park (look for sign). Turn left into Sunday Park, just beyond Brandermill Church. Follow signs for Parking. Start Point is in the Picnic Pavillion, located past the Boathouse Restaurant and Brandermill Sailing Center

**START/FINISH:** Sunday Park, 4602 Millridge Parkway, Midlothian, Virginia. We thank the Brandermill Community Association for their assistance in planning and executing this event.

**This walk is free if you don't seek AVA/IVV credit.**

**START:** Start between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm.

**FINISH TIME:** 3:00 p.m.

**DISTANCE:** 5 and 10 KM trail (3.1 & 6.2 miles). Route can be repeated one time at no additional fee.

**TRAIL RATING:** Rated 1 – An easy walk on pavement with no significant difficulty with hills. Suitable for wheel-chairs and strollers.

**AWARD:** There is no award for this event. “B” awards will be available for purchase.

**SANCTIONED:** This event is sanctioned by American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV).

**IVV BOOKS:** This event counts toward acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards. IVV event/distance books and new walker packets are available at the finish point at a cost of \$6.00 each.

**ELIGIBILITY:** This event is open to all; everyone is welcome regardless of sex, creed, race, or nationality. An adult must accompany children under the age of twelve.

**REGISTRATION:** IVV credit only is \$3. To walk without an award or credit is free, but you must carry a start card. Absolutely no refunds.

**CONDITIONS:** The walk will be held regardless of most weather conditions. Participants are requested to observe all traffic laws and to place all litter in proper receptacles. **PETS MUST BE LEASHED!**

**REFRESHMENTS:** Water will be available at start and control points.

**DISCLAIMER:** The American Volkssport Association or its subsidiary clubs are not responsible for theft or loss of personal belongings or property. All participants must sign a waiver.
