DIRECTIONS

FROM MARYLAND (SOUTH):

Take I-83 to Exit 9@ (Rt 30). Continue West on Rt 30 to the exit for Rt 74 (Carlisle Rd.). At the signal light, turn right onto Carlisle Rd. Continue to the signal light in Dover. Turn left onto Canal Rd. and continue a short distance to Dover Community Park on the right.


FROM HARRISBURG (NORTH):

Take I-83 South to Exit 10. Proceed on George St to Rt 30 West. Continue as above.

FROM LANCASTER (EAST): Take Rt 30 West to the exit for Rt 74 (Carlisle Rd). Continue as above.

FROM GETTYSBURG & POINTS WEST:

Take Rt 30 East. When the road splits near York, be sure to take Rt 30 toward Lancaster and NOT Rt 462 to York. From Rt 30, take the Rt 74 exit (Carlisle Rd.). At the signal light turn left onto Carlisle Rd. Continue to the signal light in Dover. Proceed as above.

START AREA: Dover Area Community Park - Log House, 2481 West Canal Road, Dover, PA **Free parking is available**.

START/FINISH TIME: Walk: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 Noon. Finish by 3:00 p.m.

PROCEDURE: AVA policy requires that every participant, **fee** or nonfee, sign the insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card which is stamped at control points along the course. At the Finish, the validated card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the credit fee has been paid. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

ELIGIBILITY: Everyone is welcome to participate. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Walk at your own pace.

FEES and CREDIT: This event is FREE to those who wish to participate without IVV credit. IVV credit is \$3.00. New Walker packets (a \$30+ value) will be available for those wishing to begin walking for credit.

AWARD: There will be no special award for this event. IVV Credit only.

CONDITIONS: Pets must be on a leash at all times and are not permitted in any buildings. Please clean up after your pet.

REFRESHMENTS AND RESTROOMS: Water and hard candy will be available at the Start/Finish and Check Points. Restrooms are available at the Start, the checkpoint and a few places along the trail.

COMMENTS: DOVER: The town of Dover was laid out in 1764 by Jacob Joner. Dover has seen a varied history since that time. On July 1, 1863, the village of Dover was occupied by a large cavalry force led by J.E.B. Stuart. Because of the poor means of communication at that time, they did not realize as they lingered in Dover that the first day of the Battle of Gettysburg was being fought. In 1901, Brookside Park opened and beginning in November of 1902, it was serviced by the trolley lines of the York Street Railway Company. Many families would pack their children and picnic baskets onto the trolley for a ride and spend the day at the part. One of the children's favorite attractions at the park was the large German Carousel. Unfortunately, all that remains of the carousel today is the large carousel house, a reminder of the more leisurely times of a bygone era.

TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS: Both the 10 and 5K walks are on sidewalks within the borough and along roadsides within the township. Neither walk is suitable for wheelchairs; but, with caution, large wheeled strollers could be used. There are several gradual inclines.
